In the summer term we will deliver an awards assembly in every school. We have also included two additional awards: Sports Leader Award & the Outstanding Achievement Award.

We hope that this support to schools will positively impact on the children's personal development.



Sports Leadership

It was fantastic to finally run our Y5&6 Leadership Academy Training Day earlier this month. The Leaders learnt about the essential skills, roles and responsibilities of a leader and how they could use these skills when supporting peers and younger children in their own school or leading at the SSP events, festivals and competitions.

The Leaders took part in 3 training sessions, 1: Playground Games - How to manage & lead; 2: Organising Competitions - Designing and delivering them to meet the needs of children's motivation, confidence and competence levels; and 3: Physical Activity Campaign - Influencing others to become more active.

We are looking forward to seeing how the Leaders develop once deployed into their new roles.

Quality of Education

As part of our service level agreement we have always prioritised the quality of teaching and learning in PE. We believe that if a child receives high quality PE lessons then engagement in school sport and physical activity is improved. This links to an article in our last newsletter about physical literacy skills and the 5 key outcomes: Physical Competence, Confidence, Motivation, Knowledge and Understanding.
