Spring Term 2 has seen a huge increase in participation at all partnership events, festivals and competitions following the pandemic.

This half term has had somewhat of an invasion theme with boys and girls football competitions, girl's netball alongside a Disney themed football skills festival with over 300 Y3&4 in attendance. Our KS1 pupils have attended a Buzz & Woody flight festival focussing on the fundamental movement skills of 'throw and catch', and it was great to see Kirkleatham Hall school return to taking part in events.

It was also the first term in which we have returned to using secondary school and college leaders to deliver our events and the feedback from the staff and pupils has been absolutely fantastic. Leadership is something we pride ourselves on, so it's fantastic to have the secondary schools back onboard and Redcar & Cleveland College students from public services and sport courses too.

This half term has given us hope of returning to normality and we are really pleased to see so many children and young people enjoying the opportunities we provide once more.





Active Travel

The Active Travel Team continue to deliver the Bikeability training, levels 1 and 2, balance bike training and pedestrian training in schools.
