As a lead partnership for Girls Football, our aim over the next academic year is to grow the percentage of schools providing equal access for girls through extra-curricular provision, working towards a vision of 90% by 2024. From the recent Girls Football Survey that was completed we are currently sitting at 43% so more needs to be done to support you with increasing opportunities.

Primary PE CPD

The team have compiled an extensive primary PE CPD calendar for the academic year. RESSP schools receive discounted places for this training. For a full calendar please email us.

The CPD is split into categories:

- **PE Subject Leader CPD** - Specific training for subject leaders.
- **Curriculum CPD** – Aimed at staff delivering the national curriculum PE to primary aged children.
- **Preparing to Compete CPD** – Aimed at staff that are preparing their children for competition. Including rules, skills, and drills etc.
- **Physical Activity CPD** – Linked to increasing physical activity levels: Active learning and active travel etc.
- **SEND CPD** – Specific training to help with staff's knowledge and understanding of working with pupils with SEND.

Research suggests that children and adults are more likely to keep being active if they are physically literate. This means they have the physical competence, motivation, confidence and the knowledge and understanding of why they are doing it and how to get better. If they have all of these then they will be engaged. The below table explains this.
