EVENT TYPE	Open Pathway
EVENT FORMAT	EVENT FORMAT: The event will be tiered, grouping teams based on ability – schools should select which level they wish their teams to be entered at. Competitive – All teams entered will be eligible to go forward and represent the Redcar & Eston School Sport Partnership at the Tees Valley Finals (20th March). All referees will play to full football rules. Development – Rules will be adapted where necessary and the emphasis will be on skill / game development, not winning. Beginner – Participants will be introduced to the game of football through a range of skill-based activities in a non-competitive environment, before having the opportunity to put the skills they have learnt into practice and play a game. TEAM / GROUP INFORMATION: - Schools can enter a maximum of 2 teams. There is a maximum of 10 players per team, with 7 playing at any one time.
VENUE INFO	This event will take place on the outdoor 3G pitch, indoor 3G pitch and the sportshall within Eston Leisure Centre. Please bring adequate staffing, 1 member of staff per team if possible, to support your school group and supervise toilet trips - toilets will be open, inside the venues, please note that Eston Leisure Centre will be open to the public.
EQUIPMENT	No equipment required. As this event is outdoors please bring suitable clothing & footwear.
WHAT'S NEW?	In addition to the Competitive & Development categories, there is now the 'Beginner' entry level to provide more pupils the opportunity to learn through playing the game against other schools at their level.

RULES

FOOTBALL RULES:

7-a-side game with rolling substitutes and squads are made up of up to 10 players.

Games can be either played one way or made up of two halves and time will be dependent on the number of teams entered.

- Usual football rules apply except that there is no offside.
- When the goalkeeper has the ball for a goal kick (played from the ground) opponents must retreat to their own half until the ball is in play. The goalkeeper does not have to wait for the opposition to retreat and has the option to restart the game before should they choose to.
- The opposition do not have to retreat to their own half when the goalkeeper has the ball in their arms.
- The ball is in play when it is kicked or thrown directly out of the penalty area.
- If a player intentionally passes back to their own goalkeeper with their feet, the ball may not be played with the hands, but can be played with the feet. (Default - indirect free kick from edge of the penalty area nearest to the offence).
- Players must wear suitable footwear (3G or indoor sportshall) and shin pads must be worn by all players.
