EVENT FORMAT	EVENT FORMAT: Staying within school groups, teams will rotate around 8 different tr-golf activities, set up across the 3G pitch. Schools will have 2 minutes to practice the activity, then 5 minutes to score as many points as they can. Teachers will need to help score for each team. Activities are likely to include: Grand National / Drive for Show, Putt for Dough / Finders Keepers / Dominos / Tunnel Ball / Zone Ball / Go for Green / Bullseye. Honesty is the key to this event and extra points will be awarded for this value being demonstrated. Secondary School Sports Leaders, with the support of RESSP Staff, will explain and demonstrate each of the activities. All activities will be set up in advance and all equipment provided – sports leaders will lead the activity with the support of your sports leaders (if you have any) and school staff. TEAM / GROUP INFORMATION: • Schools can enter a maximum of 3 teams of 10 – ideally 5 girls & 5 boys per team. • You are welcome to bring a couple of your Year 5 / 6 Sports Leaders to support.
VENUE INFO	This event will take place on the outdoor 3G pitch and additional grass pitches. Please bring adequate staffing, 1 member of staff per team if possible, to support your school group and supervise toilet trips - toilets will be open inside the college.
EQUIPMENT	Please bring tri-golf bag per school, including clubs & soft tri-golf balls. As this event is outdoors please bring suitable clothing & footwear.
