EVENT FORMAT	EVENT FORMAT: Inspired by the Barclays Girls Football Partnership’s ‘World’s Biggest Football Day’ to celebrate International Women’s Day, this football festival will offer all KS2 girls of mixed ages and ability the opportunity to try football and learn new skills through a range of drills and activities. The aim of the festival is to introduce the girls to football and provide them with the opportunity to develop their skills within a relaxed environment, through playing fun activities and games. The different activities and training drills will build players confidence before the girls then get the opportunity to practice what they have learnt and play some friendly matches. Secondary School Sports Leaders, with the support of RESSP Staff, will explain and demonstrate each of the activities. All activities will be set up in advance and all equipment provided – sports leaders will lead the activity with the support of your sports leaders (if you have any) and school staff. TEAM / GROUP INFORMATION: • Schools can enter a maximum of 3 teams. There is a maximum of 10 players per team, with 7 playing at any one time.
VENUE INFO	This event will take place on the outdoor 3G pitch and additional grass pitches. Please bring adequate staffing, 1 member of staff per team if possible, to support your school group and supervise toilet trips - toilets will be open inside the college.

RULES	FOOTBALL RULES: 7-a-side game with rolling substitutes and squads are made up of up to 10 players. Games can be either played one way or made up of two halves and time will be dependent on the number of teams entered. • Usual football rules apply except that there is no offside. • When the goalkeeper has the ball for a goal kick (played from the ground) opponents must retreat to their own half until the ball is in play. The goalkeeper does not have to wait for the opposition to retreat and has the option to restart the game before should they choose to. • The opposition do not have to retreat to their own half when the goalkeeper has the ball in their arms. • The ball is in play when it is kicked or thrown directly out of the penalty area. • If a player intentionally passes back to their own goalkeeper with their feet, the ball may not be played with the hands, but can be played with the feet. (Default - indirect free kick from edge of the penalty area nearest to the offence). • Players must wear suitable footwear (3G or indoor sportshall) and shin pads must be worn by all players.
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
