If anyone is unsure of any changes then please get in touch and we can make sure you get the most up to date information.

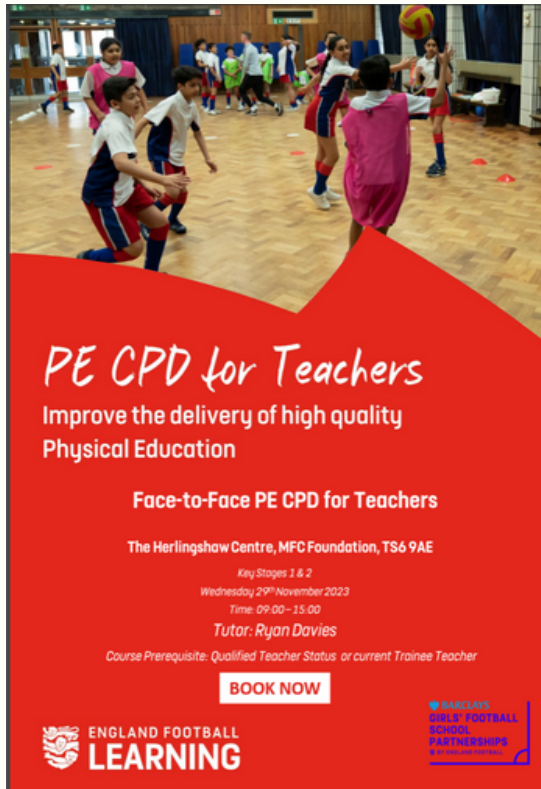
Ideally, we advise to get an action plan pulled together before October half term. It can be amended, but it shows you have started the planning process.

We look forward to working with your children on these values throughout the year.



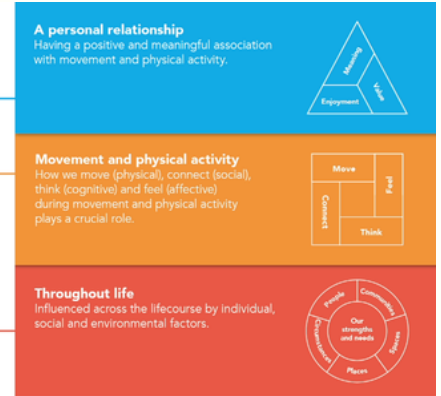

# Physical Literacy



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The Physical Literacy Consensus Statement for England has been revealed by Sport England at a conference in London at the end of September.

The Physical Literacy Consensus Statement for England has been developed to facilitate a shared understanding of physical literacy for those working in the sport, education, physical activity, recreation, play, health and youth sectors.

The statement offers a broad overview of physical literacy, why it matters and how it can be developed and supported.

Developing consensus on the term physical literacy has been a priority, as understanding what impacts people's relationship with movement and physical activity throughout life will enable those working in the sector to ensure their offer is as appealing as possible.

We will be ensuring that staff in schools understand the statement and how they can support their children and young people to ensure that our children have a positive relationship with physical activity and movement.

## School Games Mark Success

The School Games Mark (SGM) is a government led awards scheme launched in 2012 to reward schools for their commitment to the development of school sport across their school and into the community. Participating in this process allows schools to evaluate their provision and assists them in developing an action plan for future progress.
