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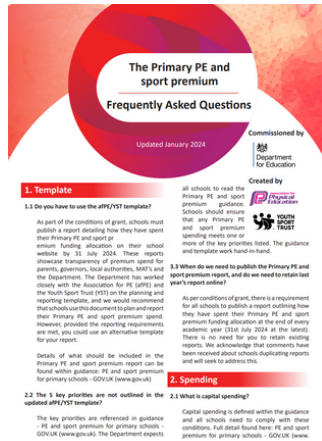
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PE Premium Funding FAQs

Youth Sport Trust Manifesto

The Youth Sport Trust are working with other national sporting organisations to influence change in Government's decisions and influence all Government parties future manifestos for PE, school sport and physical activity. We thought you would find it interesting to read what the national organisations think government priorities should be.

Manifesto:

The manifesto was developed with contributions from children and young people, teachers and school leaders, and representatives from youth, health and wellbeing, physical activity and sport organisations. It puts forward proposals to initiate the systemic change needed to transform lives.

At present, fewer than half (47%) of children are meeting the UK's Chief Medical Officers' guidelines for being physically active.

A young person who is physically active on a regular basis will have better mental health, physical health and social wellbeing – however at present, too many children are missing out.

The manifesto calls for a new, long-term joined-up national plan guaranteeing every child access to 60 minutes a day of PE, sport and play by creating a nation of active and well schools.

Underpinned by investment and supported by a campaign to raise awareness of recommended activity levels, this plan should:

1. Resource a **dedicated coordination and delivery team** working across a family of schools in every community.
2. Introduce a new **national wellbeing measurement for children**, to track progress and target interventions.
3. **Protect and increase spaces** for play and physical activity in every locality, and provide co-curricular sport for all children.
4. Reimagine Physical Education, making it a **core subject** developing physically literate children, healthy learners and active citizens
5. Formalise existing youth sport leadership opportunities into a **national young sport volunteers programme** delivering year-round social action.
