Parental Engagement Video



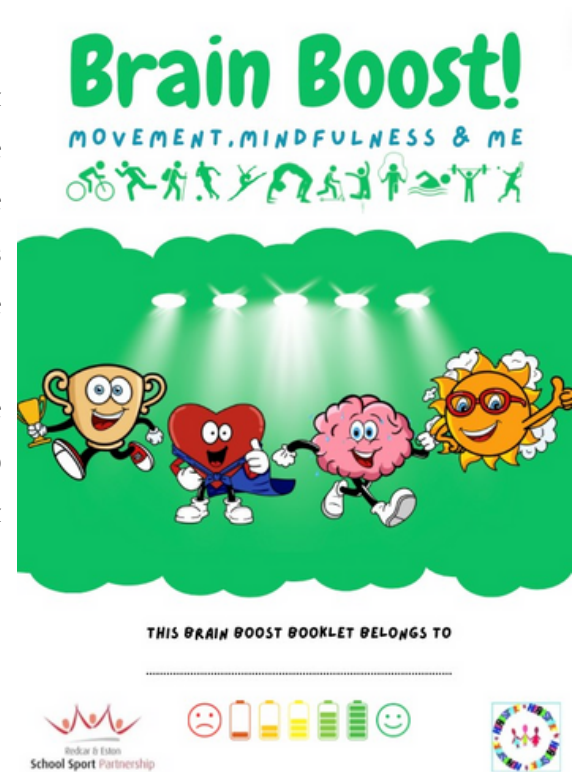
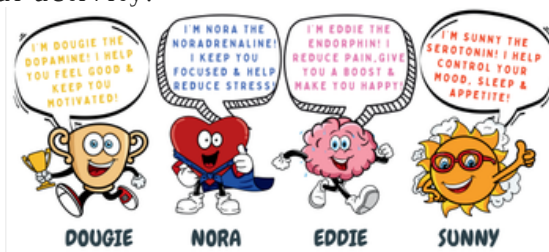

Staff CPD

This academic year we decided to ask PE Subject Leaders and those teaching PE to complete a self review tool. This gave us and the Subject Leaders an overall picture of staff's competence and confidence levels and all of our training was then linked to these completed reviews.

We held central training for PE Subject Leaders at our half termly meetings and delivered whole staff and individual staff training for schools based on their reviews.

The Subject Leaders have asked to continue this into 24-25 and the blank reviews have been sent out in anticipation of the 24-25 academic year. Hopefully these will also show progression in staff's competence and confidence levels too.

We will also be delivering a central Primary PE CPD calendar and this has already been sent out to schools.
