Family After School Club

Last year we were able to run some pilot Family After school Clubs within some of our primary schools. The aim of the club was family engagement - for children and parents/carers to take part in fun games together whilst being physically active. We hoped that showing the children and their parents/carers easy games to play within small spaces and with minimal equipment they could continue to be active as a family within their own time. We showed them that being active can be fun and easy with no cost and can be played at home or in a local park.

We produced a **Move with Me** booklet for families to take home. Reminding them of games and give ideas for leading a healthy lifestyle.

Having now gathered feedback from these sessions we will be sharing what worked well with all PE subject leaders. If schools are looking to develop family engagement this may be worth trying and we can provide ideas to replicate this within your schools.
