PE Premium Funding

For 2024-25 academic year DfE have tightened up their guidance. Full guidance can be found [here](#). This academic year will also see a governmental review on the funding and the impact it makes. To support schools in the partnership to make sure they are being compliant we are doing the following:

- Attending National webinar on your behalf.
- Shared recording of that webinar - This can be found [here](#).
- PE Subject Leader training in Oct 2024 at the half termly meeting.
- Optional one to one support to plan spending for the year.
- AfPE CEO attending Tees Valley PE Conference in January 2025 to deliver a workshop.
- Digital reporting window opens for 8 weeks in the summer term. We will offer one to one support if required to complete this reporting.

Planning your spend and impact is essential now and we can support you to make sure you are compliant. Please don't wait until the summer to check if a spend is eligible. Funding will be reclaimed by DfE.

As a reminder: your planning action plan still needs to be on your school website. It is recommended to use the National template for this.



Tees Valley Primary PE Conference 2025

Every two years we host the Tees Valley Primary PE Conference. We work with our colleagues across Tees Valley to host the conference. Bookings will go live next week (Wednesday 27th November). As you know, this is always a popular event and we are unfortunately only able to offer 250 places due to the fire regulations of the Riverside Stadium. I therefore urge you to get your bookings done as soon as possible. For schools that are in the partnership we offer a FREE place to one Headteacher and one PE Subject Leader per school. Additional places cost £75 per person and can only be offered once bookings are closed. If you would like an additional place then you will be added to the waiting list.

Storytelling

One of the greatest ways to show impact is through story telling. As a partnership we get to hear some of the impact stories of the work we all do as a Partnership but it would be great if you could share more. This not only inspires us in our jobs but also helps us to understand the impact PE, physical activity and school sport is making on the children and young people across Redcar & Eston.

One story we would love to share with you this half term is from Zetland Primary School:

RESSP went in to school to deliver level 1 Bikeability training with Year 4 pupils. On arrival the instructors realised that out of 30 pupils 16 could not ride a bike. Luckily we had more instructors in attendance than needed, so the team managed to work with the non-riders over the 4 hour period, taking small groups out to support them on their bikes, the end result was amazing. 14 children out of the 16 managed to ride independently without any support or assistance! This was a fantastic achievement, the children were amazing and so happy with themselves. The instructors were so inspired by how the children motivated each other. That evening one of the children's parents filmed their child riding around the park and sent the video into school to show her gratitude and how proud she was of her child. Such an emotional moment for the parent.

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Sports Leadership Training

This half term we have been delivering sports leadership training to your young people.

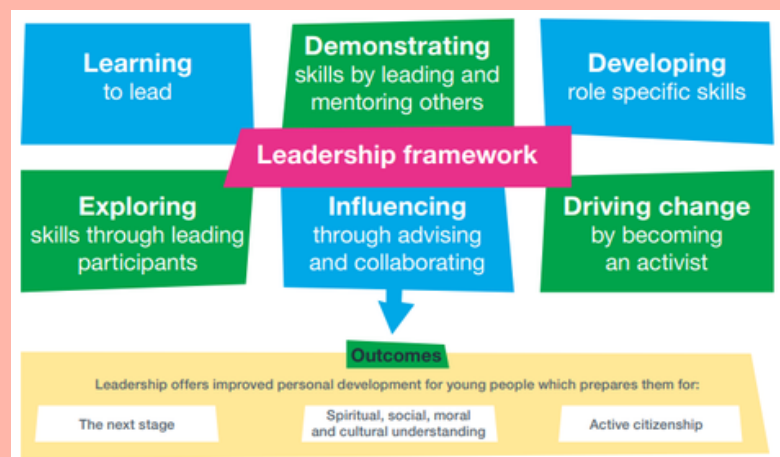
We have worked with the 5 Secondary Schools and Redcar College to upskill students to help support our festivals and events.

Balance Bikes

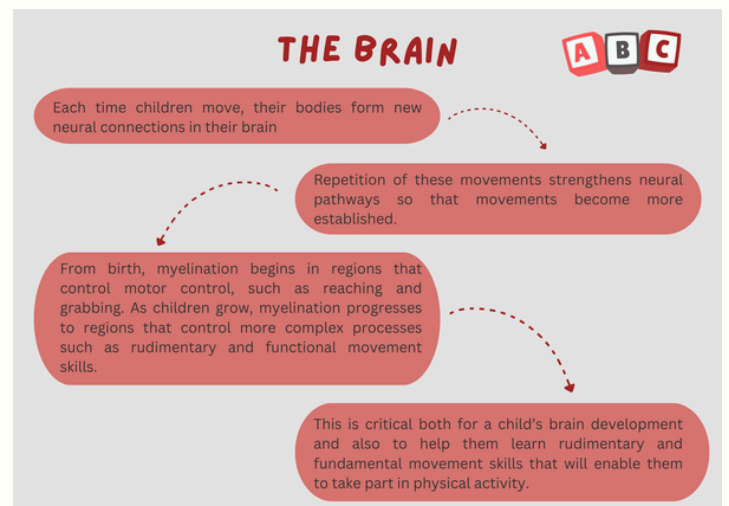
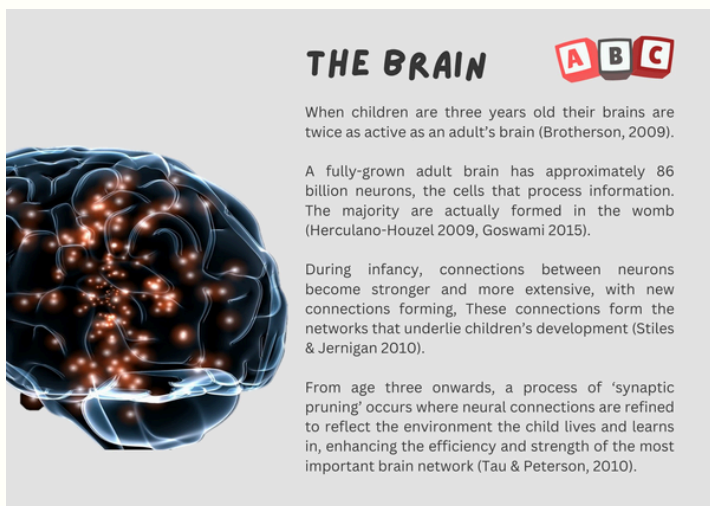
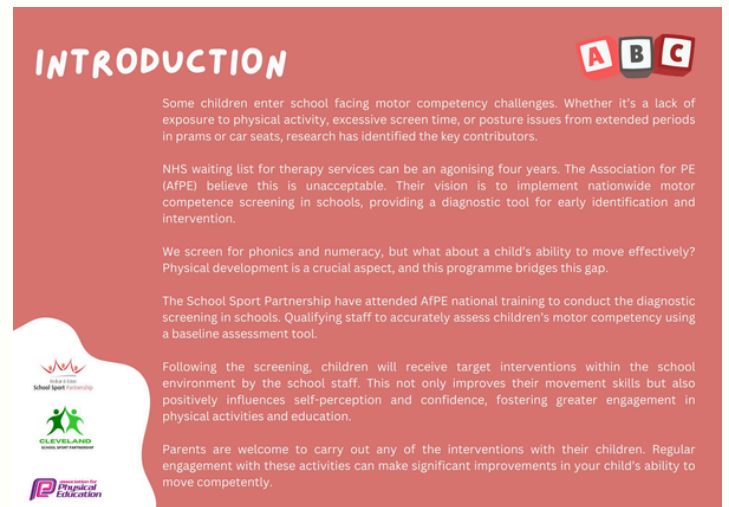
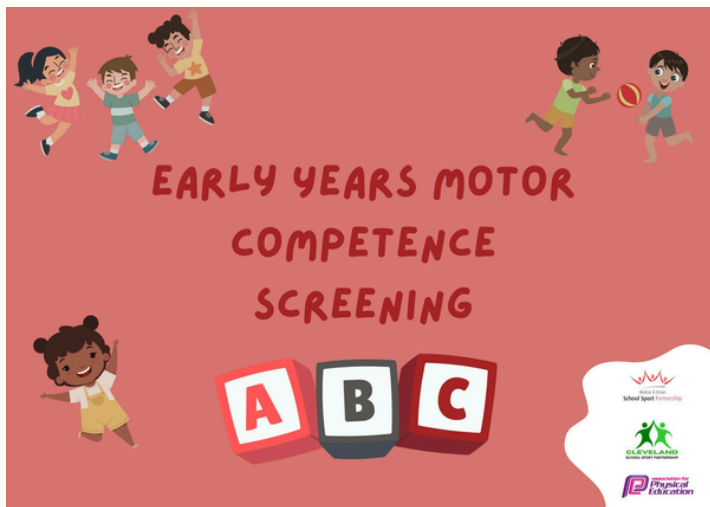
You should have recently received an email from us about The Bikeability Trust offer. They are launching the Get Cycling in Schools programme. This is a fantastic initiative designed to enhance cycling skills among young pupils in nursery, reception, and Year 1. This project, funded by the Department for Transport and supported by the Department for Education, aims to equip schools with the resources and training necessary to foster a love of cycling from an early age.

Early Years Motor Screening

We have recently qualified to carry out Motor Competence Screening with Early Years aged children. We will shortly be filming the supporting videos and will then roll the programme out to any partnership schools wanting to get involved. We will come into school to do the screening and assign each child to an intervention group: A, B or C. We will then leave a resource with supporting materials for the school to carry out the interventions for the appropriate groups. Below is a sneak preview of the introduction to the school resource which gives you a little bit of detail of why this programme is needed. Realistically we will start taking bookings for this in the new year.
