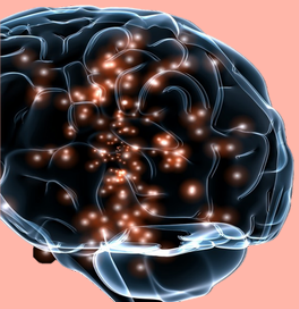

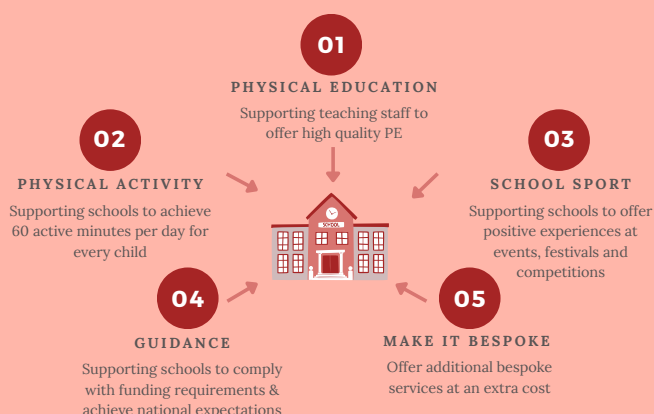

We are now a team of nine staff. 30% of the staffing bill is covered by your Service Level Agreement payments. The remaining 70% is covered by external funding brought in.

Service Level Agreement



We are waiting for DfE to confirm the PE Premium Funding for the 2025-26 academic year. Once this announcement is made we will send out our service level agreement. We would already like to confirm there will not be a price increase. A couple of schools have already been in touch regarding this so they can set their new budget. We will continue to support your schools in the five main areas:



Spirit of the Games Assemblies

We will be delivering assemblies in each of your schools during the Week of 7th - 11th July 2025. Similar to previous years we have asked each school to award one child from each year group (Y1-6) on each of the six Spirit of the Games. In our assembly we will talk about these values and present a certificate and badge to the award winners.

Barclay Girls Football School Partnership

As a Girls Football Partnership we have been working with our 5 secondary schools to develop Girls Football Activators. We are now tasking these leaders with helping us to deliver some Girls Football Festivals in partnership with local football clubs and community football providers. Schools will be invited along to a festival held at a community venue to help provide exit pathways for girls into recreational football.

The dates for these events are:

- 29th April - Y3/4 Girls - MFC Foundation, Eston
- 20th May - Y5/6 Girls - Mo Mowlem Memorial Park, Redcar Town FC
- 17th June - Y3/4 Girls - Redcar & Cleveland College

We will also be asking your school to complete the national annual girls football equal access survey to see which schools provide equal opportunities in football within the curriculum and in extra curricular. This link will be sent out after Easter.
