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PE Premium Reporting Webinar

As you know DfE have introduced a new digital reporting tool for the PE Premium funding. Introduced to tighten up the accountability for this funding. The tool was piloted last academic year and has been tweaked ready for this academic year. I have shared the questions with PE Subject Leaders for last year, but I have not seen the tweaks. DfE are working with the Youth Sport Trust (YST) and the Association for PE (AfPE) to deliver a webinar on how to complete the reporting tool. Myself and Louise will be attending and will obviously feed back to schools, but you are more than welcome to attend the webinar too. It is FREE!

PE Premium Funding

Unfortunately DfE have still not made an announcement about the PE Premium Funding for 25-26 academic year. I do however work very closely with both AfPE and YST and both have regular meetings with the DfE about the funding. They have recently made positive noises about the funding. They have told us that it will only be a short term announcement for the next academic year and then the Comprehensive Spend Review will determine future long term funding.

The funding we receive direct to employ a School Games Organiser (£23K) is under review too. We are aware of discussion about joining this funding together nationally to make something better for School Sport. Luckily I have been sitting on the working groups for this and if it receives government backing then this will be a positive move for us.

As soon as I am aware of any announcements for the funding I will let you all know. I really appreciate you all signing your SLAs for next year without this guarantee. Obviously if the funding does not come then we will not hold you to this.

YST and AfPE think an announcement will be made before the above webinar so that people do not flood this webinar with questions and concerns about future funding. My fingers are crossed.

School Games Mark

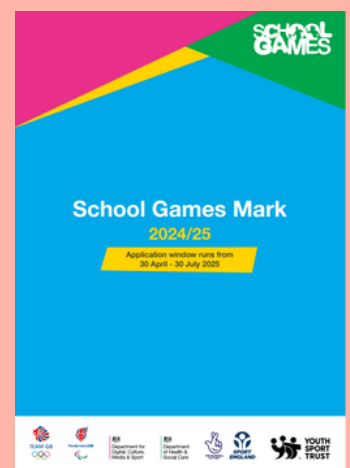
The annual School Games Mark application window is open now until 30th July 2025. The new guidance can be found on the School Games Website: www.yourschoolgames.com

Spirit of the Games Assemblies

We will be delivering assemblies in each of your schools during the Week of 7th - 11th July 2025. Similar to previous years we have asked each school to award one child from each year group (Y1-6) on each of the six Spirit of the Games. In our assembly we will talk about these values and present a certificate and badge to the award winners.



Discounts for Partnership Schools

As you know we work closely with many organisations that can help your school to provide more opportunities for children to be active and to support your staff's confidence and competence to deliver. Here are a couple of discounts from trusted organisations we are currently working with. These discounts are only available to partnership schools:

COMPLETE PE:

Instead of a one off payment of £1500+VAT, they reduce this for our schools down to £975+VAT, so it's a discount of £525. Also, schools won't pay the £175+VAT annual membership until October 2026, so they get a year free.

From 1st September 2025, their costs are increasing in line with the content significantly increasing on Complete PE. Therefore, from 1st September the offer will be a one off payment of £1075+VAT, so a discount of £425+VAT. The membership will remain the same at £175+VAT but won't be payable until October 2026.



OPAL:

For the 25/26 academic year they are offering a £550 discount off the price of the programme which is currently £5500. A 10% discount, but schools must inform OPAL they are part of RESSP.
