It is lovely for us to come into school and celebrate the children's achievements.

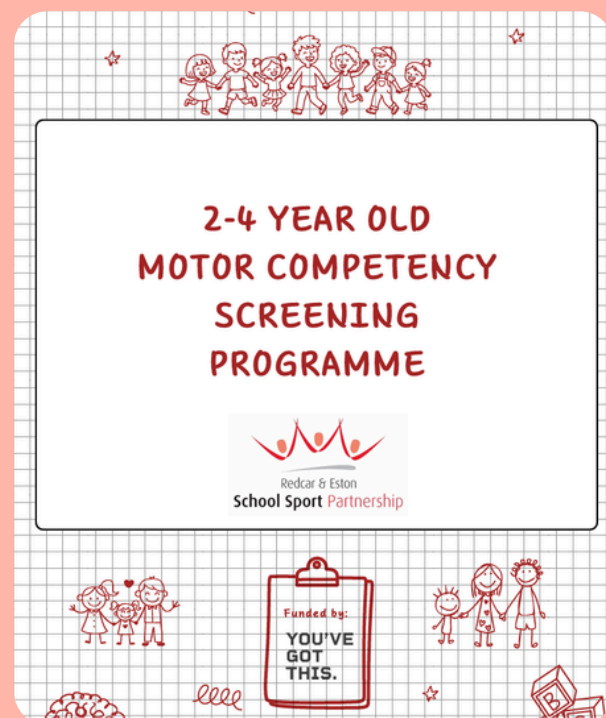

2 - 4 Year Old Motor Screening

Coming Soon.....

Some children enter school facing motor competency challenges. Whether it's a lack of exposure to physical activity, excessive screen time or posture issues from extended periods in prams or car seats, research has identified the key contributors. The vision is to implement a younger motor competence screening programme, providing an even earlier diagnostic tool for early identification and intervention. We screen for phonics and numeracy, but what about a child's ability to move effectively? Physical development is a crucial aspect and this programme bridges this gap. We will be in touch with schools soon.

PE Premium Digital Reporting

Schools must complete the digital expenditure reporting return at the end of the academic year.

The return outlines how you has used your PE and sport premium funding and the impact your spending has had on achieving the aims and objectives of the funding.

Guidance on how to complete the return will come out before the 2025 to 2026 reporting window opens.

Schools should be starting to collate expenditure details and impact ready for completion.
