Falls & Trips	All group members	L	X	L	=	L	Pitches to be checked before the event starts to make sure it is safe. First aider with first aid kit available but suggest school staff administer treatment. School staff to ensure pupils wear appropriate footwear.	L
Weather	All group members	L	X	M	=	M	Event will not take place if weather is too wet or cold. Schools should advise children to bring relevant clothing e.g. layers & waterproofs in case of cold or wet weather or sun cream / hats etc. in warm weather.	L
Venue (Open to Public)	All group members	L	X	M	=	M	Children to be briefed about members of the public using the caravan site at the top of the field within the rugby club grounds. Children are to stay with their group and not talk to strangers. Staff accompanying the pupils will have responsibility for their own pupils and ensure the pupils abide by these rules.	L

FURTHER CONTROLS:

- First aid kit on site and mobile phone
- All school staff to have consent and medical information on all children
- School staff to be responsible for their group whilst at the competition
- Suitable clothing and footwear for sports activities
- Briefing with each group before starting (safety and appropriate behaviour)
- Competition will be cancelled if weather is too wet or cold.
- Children advised by schools to bring warm clothing in case of wet or cold weather conditions
- Covid restrictions if necessary, distancing, masks and hand sanitising will be discussed
