Any reason for leaving the sports hall e.g. toilet trips will be accompanied and supervised by a member of school staff. Pupils will be expected to stay in the area allocated to their activity. Staff accompanying the pupils will have responsibility for their own pupils and ensure the pupils abide by these rules.	L

FURTHER CONTROLS:

- First aid kit on site and qualified first aiders with a mobile phone.
- All school staff to have consent and medical information on all children.
- School staff to be responsible for their group whilst at the event - need adequate ratio of staff to children.
- Suitable clothing and footwear for sports activities.
- Briefing with each group before starting event (safety and appropriate behaviour).
- Covid restrictions if necessary, distancing, masks and hand sanitising will be discussed.

Probability Key:
